Thistle Community Housing is a non-profit organization that is part of the heart and soul of affordable housing in Boulder County. Our mission is to produce, preserve & protect quality, permanently affordable rental homes and homeownership opportunities for moderate and lower-income individuals and families, seniors, veterans and people with disabilities.

In addition, part of our values here at Thistle is to foster strong connections with our residents and to ensure a safe and secure living environment. The strategic installation and maintenance of surveillance cameras in common areas, entrances and exits, parking lots, and other relevant locations of Thistle's properties. This allows Thistle to enhance the safety and security of residents while protecting personal space, property and deterring criminal activities, as well as to react quickly to any and all security threats.

Please note privacy considerations are paramount to Thistle, ensuring cameras are not placed in areas of residents' reasonable expectation of privacy. Access to camera footage is restricted to authorized personnel only, with transparent protocols for law enforcement requests. Residents will be informed of the surveillance cameras through clear signage and communication, and their feedback regarding camera placement and privacy concerns will be considered.

Please also note, the main intention for the installation and placement of surveillance cameras is to ensure a safe, secure, and respectful living environment for all Thistle residents. The quality of life, comfort, and safety of our Thistle residents in their own home ensures peace of mind and a stable, healthy living environment.

While all of our Longmont properties have security cameras, Thistle Community Housing looks forward to having security cameras at all of our Boulder locations in the near future.
